Directions to Chicago Office
James R. Thompson Center
100 W. Randolph, Suite 15-200

From Lake Shore Drive

Exit at Randolph Street. Proceed west. The Thompson Center is at Randolph and Clark streets.

From the south-Dan Ryan Expressway (I-90/I-94)

Exit at Lake Street. Turn right and proceed east to LaSalle Street. The Thompson Center is at Lake and LaSalle streets.

From Indiana

By car, take the Chicago Skyway (I-90 tollway) to Dan Ryan Expressway (I-90/I-94). Then follow directions above. Or take the South Shore Railroad to the Millennium Station. Exit station at Randolph and walk west four blocks.

From the north/northwest-Kennedy Expressway (I-90/I-94)

Exit at Ohio Street. Proceed east to LaSalle Street. Turn right and continue south to Lake Street. The Thompson Center is on LaSalle between Lake and Randolph.

From the west-Eisenhower Expressway (I-290)

Exit at Franklin Street. Proceed north to Lake Street. Turn right and proceed east to LaSalle Street. The Thompson Center is on Lake between LaSalle and Clark.

From the southwest-Stevenson Expressway (I-55)

Exit at Dan Ryan Expressway (I-90/I-94). Proceed west on Dan Ryan Expressway and follow directions above.

From Union Station (Amtrak and Metra) - walk (about 10 minutes) or take cab (about \$5)

Exit at Adams or Madison streets. Turn right and continue east to LaSalle Street. Turn left and walk north to Randolph.

From O'Hare Airport

Take the CTA Blue Line to Clark/Lake (Thompson Center). By car, follow the directions above for the Kennedy Expressway. A cab will cost \$30-\$35.

From Midway Airport

Take the CTA Orange Line to Clark/Lake (Thompson Center). By car, follow signs to Stevenson Expressway (I-55) north. Then follow directions above. A cab will cost about \$20-\$25.

From CTA Rail Lines

The CTA Blue, Green, Pink, Purple Express, Brown and Orange lines all stop at the Clark/Lake (Thompson Center) station. The CTA Red Line stops at Lake Street (two blocks east of the Thompson Center). For CTA rail and bus information call (312) 836-7000 or visit www.transitchicago.com.
