- Reason for Emergency: The Green Cleaning Schools Act became effective August 13, 2007. The Act required the Illinois Green Governments Coordinating Council to promulgate these guidelines and specifications. The authorizing law for the Illinois Green Governments Coordinating Council (Pubic Act 95-657) did not become effective until October 17, 2007. Thus, the development of the guidelines and specifications was delayed. The Green Cleaning Schools Act required the Council to promulgate the guidelines and specifications no later than February 11, 2008. The issuance of rules at this time will promote public safety and allow schools sufficient time to comply with the guidelines for the next school year.
- 10) <u>A Complete Description of the Subjects and Issues Involved</u>: The Green Cleaning Schools Act was adopted to protect the environmental and occupant health of primary and secondary schools. There is a threat to the pubic interest. In order to implement these
